



Great Adventure Permission Slip – 5/30/17

On **TUESDAY, MAY 30, 2017**, Holmstead School will go on a field trip to Great Adventure. We will leave promptly at 8:45 a.m. **Students will return to school approximately at 5:30 p.m.** and will need transportation home promptly at that time. **Students NOT going on the trip MUST have the permission slip signed indicating an excused absence provided they have not exceeded their district attendance policy.** There will be staff here to monitor academic make up work for those students needing to attend school. Students going on the trip are encouraged to bring cell phones. A staff member will have a Holmstead cell phone in order to communicate with

students to better ensure a prompt departure time.

Students are to meet at the Great Adventure fountain at 3:30 p.m. for the return to Holmstead. Students will be able to use their cell phones to call home when we are able to better estimate the arrival time back at school. The trip is free of charge; however, all school debts must be paid before the student is allowed to attend. Fundraising and the school will cover the remaining cost.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, CONSENT AND RELEASE

I, the undersigned parent and/or guardian of the student named below, hereby acknowledge that I am aware that said student will be participating in the trip to Great Adventure. I consent to said student going on the trip and further, I consent to permitting the student to leave premises of Holmstead School to travel to and from Great Adventure on **TUESDAY, MAY 30, 2017**. I hereby agree to waive, release and discharge all rights and claims in respect of damage or injury sustained by my child resulting from travel and participation in the trip, except to the extent and in the amount covered by accident or liability insurance. I understand that students will return to school at approximately **5:30 p.m.** and must be picked up at that time.

Furthermore, I understand that the student is fully responsible for reporting to the bus promptly at the appointed departure time of **3:30 p.m.**

Students who do not report to the bus at 3:30 p.m. will be left at Great Adventure. I understand that each student will remain responsible during transit and at Great Adventure for complying with all the rules and regulations of Holmstead School and that each student will be subject to disciplinary standards and procedures as if on the school premises. I further understand that it would be my responsibility as a parent/guardian to provide transportation for the return trip from Great Adventure in the event that said student does not report to the bus on time for departure, or is asked to leave the park by the authority of Great Adventure Commission.

There will be one bus - the first 45 students handing in permission slips will be on the bus.

Supervision of students does not extend 15 minutes beyond return to Holmstead from Great Adventure.



Students who have had disciplinary issues prior to May 30th may be removed from the trip as a consequence for their behavior.
