

iPhone

Launch the Safari browser and navigate to holmstead.org. Tap the Share button on the browser's toolbar — that's the rectangle with an arrow pointing upward. It's on the bar at the top of the screen on an iPad, and on the bar at the bottom of the screen on an iPhone. Tap the Add to Home Screen icon in the Share menu.

Android

Launch Chrome for Android and navigate to holmstead.org. Tap the menu button then tap Add to home screen. You'll be able to enter a name for the shortcut and then Chrome will add it to your home screen.

Windows

Launch Internet Explorer. Tap the More (...) button then tap pin to start in the menu.

If you have another type of smartphone or tablet, it probably has this feature, too. Just open its browser and look in its menu for an option named something like "Add to home screen" or "Pin to home screen."

To remove a website shortcut from your device's home screen, just long-press the shortcut and remove it like you would any other app icon.
