I, the undersigned parent and/or guardian of the student named below, hereby acknowledge that I am aware that said student will be participating in the trip to New York City. I consent to said student going on the trip and further, I consent to permitting the student to leave premises of the Holmstead School to travel to and from **New York City on Wednesday, January 9th, 2019**. I hereby agree to waive, release and discharge all rights and claims in respect of damage or injury sustained by my child resulting from travel and participation in the trip, except to the extent and in the amount covered by accident or liability insurance. I understand that students will leave school **at 11:30 a.m.** and will return to school at **4:30 p.m. and must be picked up by parents/guardian at that time**. Cell phones will be permitted on the trip in order to keep in touch regarding arrival time. In the event that it is anticipated that the bus will arrive back to Holmstead earlier, parents will be called to alert them to the earlier arrival time. Please be flexible and available to pick up your son/daughter at the adjusted arrival time. **Staff members will not be expected to stay late with students awaiting parent pick-up. Please arrive promptly in order to prevent your son/daughter from being unsupervised.**

Furthermore, I understand that the student is fully responsible for reporting to the bus promptly at the appointed departure time. **Students who do not report to the bus will be left in New York City.**

I understand that each student will remain responsible during transit and in New York City for complying with all the rules and regulations of the Holmstead School and that each student will be subject to disciplinary standards and procedures the same as if on the school premises.

I further understand that it would be my responsibility as a parent/guardian to provide transportation for the return trip from New York City.
